How do I access Halsbury's?

Log on to LexisNexis AU at: www.lexisnexis.com/au/legal

- 1. From the **My Sources** panel, if you have *Halsbury's Laws of Australia* selected as a source, click Search or Browse to search or browse *Halsbury's Laws of Australia*; or
- 2. From the Quick Find panel, type in Halsbury's Laws of Australia in Source by title:

Enter your search terms into multiple fields individually or in combination:

Search Terms:	Allows you to specify words or terms you wish to find, for example, "director w/5 duty".			
References to Legislation:	Enter the legislation title and provision number (if required) to find references, for example, "corporations act w/s 588g".			
References to Cases:	Enter the name of one or both parties, or a case citation, to find references, for example, "black and garnock".			
Commentary	Allows you to specify words or terms you wish to find in paragraph headings, for example, "director w/5 duty".			
Headings:	Alternatively, enter the name of a paragraph or a paragraph number to go directly to that paragraph.
